ENTRY FORM INFORMATION

CATEGORIES

(Limit of TWO entries per category, except for Display.)

BED QUILTS SIZE = larger than 63" x 87"

(sizes: Twin, Full, Queen or King)

Bed Quilts - 1 person

1. a. Hand Appliquéd - Hand Quilted
- b. Machine Appliquéd - Standard Machine Quilted
2. a. Pieced - Hand Quilted
- b. Pieced - Standard Machine Quilted
3. Mixed Techniques - Whole Cloth, Cathedral Window, Yo-Yo, Fold & Finish, Tied, Embroidery, Etc.

Quilted

4. Appliquéd or Pieced by Long Arm Machine Owner

Bed Quilts - 2 people or more

5. Any Technique - Standard Machine Quilted

Bed Quilts - Long Arm Quilted:

2 people only (top maker and long arm quilter)

6. Pieced - size 78" x 87" or smaller (example: Twin or Full)
7. Pieced - size 84" x 92" or larger (example: Queen or King)
8. Appliquéd - Hand or Machine Appliquéd
9. Mixed Techniques (example: art quilt, whole cloth, etc.)

Bed Quilts - Long Arm Quilted:

3 or more people and long arm quilter

10. Pieced - size 78" x 87" or smaller (example: Twin or Full)
11. Pieced - size 84" x 92" or larger (example: Queen or King)
12. Appliquéd - Hand or Machine Appliquéd
13. Mixed Techniques (example: art quilt, whole cloth, etc.)

Bed Quilts - Other

14. "Senior Quilter" top maker **and** person who quilted the quilt, either Standard Machine or Long Arm, **OVER** the age of 65 years.
15. "New Quilter" - quilting for **less than 2 years** any Bed Quilt larger than 50" x 50"

Wall Hangings - 1 person

16. Wall Quilt over 45" Pieced, Hand and/or Machine Quilted
17. Wall Quilt over 45" Appliquéd, Hand and/or Machine

18. Wall Quilt 24" - 45" Pieced, Hand and/or Machine Quilted

19. Wall Quilt 24" - 45" Appliquéd, Hand and/or Machine Quilted

20. Wall Quilt under 24" - All Techniques

Wall Hangings - 2 or more people

21. Group Wall Quilt - Hand, Standard Machine or Long Arm Quilted

Clothing -

22. Clothing, All Techniques

Decorative items -

23. Decorative Accessories - pillows, bags, table runners, etc.

Children's Quilts -

24. Item created by a child 12 years old and under

25. Item created by a child 13-17 years old

Display Items -

26. Display Only, Not Judged

1. All items entered must be made completely by the entrant (except for those items entered as "Group Quilts" in categories 5-13 and 21).
2. Space will be limited. The show committee reserves the right to accept, reject, or reclassify items. Quilts in this show may be photographed by the public.
3. **ENTRY FORMS & FEES.** Entry forms must be received no later than September 15, 2010. A separate entry form must be filled out for each item. Feel free to make copies of the entry form. You may enter as many items as you wish, but only TWO items per category. (There is no limit to the number of items you enter in category 26, Display.) ENTRY FEE IS \$5.00 FOR EACH ITEM, INCLUDING DISPLAY ITEMS. Mail entry forms and entry fees to: Sally Knobloch, N2106 Irish Court, La Crosse, WI 54601.
4. Although we cannot provide insurance coverage for your items, there will be overnight security. Some Homeowner's and Renter's insurance policies may cover your items away from home.
5. **DELIVERING QUILTS.** Please deliver your items to the Omni Center, 255 Riders Club Road, Onalaska, WI between 8:00 AM - 9:00 AM on Friday, October 15, 2010. Fold quilts so that the hanging sleeve is on the outside. Enter through the front doors. Display of entries delivered later than 9:00 AM will be at the discretion of the show chair people. For SPECIAL drop offs contact Marsha Griffin, 2003 Franklin Street, Onalaska, 608-317-5755. Show hours are Saturday, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM and Sunday 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM. All entries must be left on display until 3:00 PM on Sunday, October 17, 2010.
6. **MAILING ITEMS.** Any item being mailed by UPS must reach us by Monday, October 11, 2010. We will return items via UPS if you provide a box, plastic bag, complete mailing label and \$20.00 for return postage. These items should be sent to: Sally Knobloch, N2106 Irish Court, La Crosse, WI 54601.
7. **CHECKOUT PROCEDURE.** Checkout will be Sunday, October 17, 2010, 3:30 PM - 4:00 PM. Prizes and awards may be picked up at the same time. Fines for missing hanging sleeves must be paid before you may pick up your entries. Claim checks you received when dropping off your items must be presented to pick up your items. If you are not present by 4:00 PM to pick up your items, contact chair persons listed below for directions on how to get your items.
8. **PRIZES.** Up to \$1,350 in prizes will be awarded. First Place in each category will receive a monetary award and a ribbon. Second and Third Places will receive ribbons. "Best of Show" and "Viewer's Choice" awards will receive a monetary award and special ribbons.
9. **HANGING SLEEVE & LABEL.** For display at the show, your quilt **MUST** have a 4-inch wide hanging sleeve extending the full width of the entry, to protect the quilt from the metal pipes used to hang the items. If your quilt hangs longer than 90 inches, the top of the hanging sleeve must be sewn 85 inches from the bottom of the quilt. If we must attach a hanging sleeve to your item to meet these guidelines, you will be charged \$10.00, to be paid when the entry is picked up. Put a secured (sewn on) label on the BACK of your quilt listing your name and address.

To make a hanging sleeve, take a piece of material 8 inches wide and the width of your quilt top. Fold in half and sew to form a tube. Baste it securely (both sides) across the top of the quilt (or 85 inches if the quilt is longer than 85 inches), leaving the ends open to insert the pipe.
